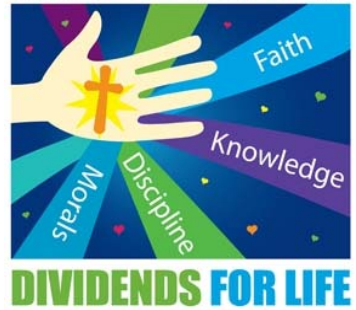


CATHOLIC SCHOOLS
